1. Welcome: A welcome was given to all present at the meeting by our Chairman Paul Edey.
2. Minutes of the last meeting: Were read and signed as a true record by our Chairman.
3. Matters Arising: There were no matters arising.
4. St Davids Museum: This matter to be discussed further down the agenda.

5. Reports:

a) **Treasurer:** £2852.00 Memory Cafe, Forum £197.00, Insurance £230.00 paid. A cheque of £250.00 is still to be received.

b) **Memory Cafe:** Annie Halliwell gave a comprehensive report, stating that a Day out in the park led by Park Warden Paul Casson is planned for the near future. Members of the café to be involved in the planning. Gareth and Deborah John have offered a piece of land for a Sensory Garden. The piece at present is not suitable as there are steps involved making it not suitable for wheelchairs etc.

Melanie and Annie discussed if it was possible for a memory orchard to also include a sensory garden. Other possible sites suggested were Nona's garden and possible areas around the Cathedral. Annie also reported that new members were still coming from the St Davids Peninsula.

7. Museum:

There has been no action since last meeting. The Ebenezer Vestry still seems to be the most suitable place.

Paul stated that we need to find out who to contact. The income that the pottery group pay for their use in the summer months needs to be taken into consideration as part of discussions with the Deacons.
